Eduthon is the collaboration of programmers, designers, and inventors to code, design, and build innovative solutions that tackle real-world problems caused in the education sector due to the corona pandemic. Its a weekend of geeking at its finest for improving the industries that affect all that live or work in a house or building. It has quickly become a global community of innovators that include all elements of the build environment.

Education is what survives when what has been learned has been forgotten. India came under the wave of corona pandemic in March, followed by a lockdown. Everyone was talking about how this will impact the industries, jobs, etc. but an important topic like education skipped everyone's minds. - 2. OCTOCAT CHALLENGE:- This event was launched on 5 August 2020 and invited all to showcase their creativity with an impressive OCTOCAT based on the theme "Education in Quarantine." Overwhelming participation and many brilliant and creative entries have been seen up till now. The winner will be awarded with cool figurines and goodies from GitHub.
- 3. **EDU-TALKS:-** EDUtalks are a series of talks scheduled for the week before the Hackathon wherein ten speakers are invited to hold interactive sessions and workshops on a wide variety of tech-related topics.
