The meeting was chaired by Dr. Arun Mohan Sherry, Director IIIT Lucknow. At the outset of the meeting, the Chairperson welcomed the participants and thanked them for taking

their time out to attend the meeting. Thereafter, with the permission of the Chairperson, the agenda items and annexure were presented before the members of BoG.

	The Director apprised the members about: -				
	Academic Programmes, Student Strength, Student Admission Data for Undergraduate, Post Graduate & Ph.D. Programmes, Construction Status, Details of Projects at IIIT Lucknow, Setup of Incubation Centre at IIIT Lucknow, Student's placement status of IIIT Lucknow, MoUs with organizations, Implementation of NEP 2020, Faculty Achievements, First Convocation of IIIT Lucknow and Challenges & Issues.				
	It was apprised to the members that around 962 students are enrolled in various academic programs starting from UG level to Ph.D.				
	In the Director's report, the members were delighted to note that the students having 99 and above percentile in JEE have taken admission in the Institute. The Director also apprised that the provisions of NEP are being gradually implemented in all the programmes offered by the Institute.				
	Members particularly praised the Institute for providing 100% placement to the B. Tech students and noted the yearly increase in average and the highest placement packages.				
	Further, the members of the BoG were also apprised of various challenges and issues: It was apprised by the Director that there is only one Hostel in the campus and there would be a requirement of accommodation for around 1000 students in view of increased intake of students in various programmes. The construction of new hostel building is under consideration.				
	Overall, the members were very pleased by the Institute's performance at this stage.

	The Action Taken report was placed before the members. The BoG took note of the same with following observations: - ATR 11- In respect of Resolution No. 1.5.4 of the First Meeting of BoG dt. 16.11.2021 wherein, it was resolved by the BoG that the Institute should speed up the process of construction of new Hostels, the drawing and estimates as received from UPRNN for the construction of a 474 bedded hostel at a tentative cost of Rs.40 Crore were placed before the BoG. It was apprised that the hostel is the priority of the Institute and the Institute may be permitted to initiate the process of construction of a boys' hostel. The availability of funds with the Institute for the purpose has also been communicated.				
	ATR-13 The matter regarding the transfer of land from the Technical Education Department, Uttar Pradesh to IIIT Lucknow was also discussed in the meeting. The Special Secretary, Dept. of Technical Education U.P, present in the meeting, was requested to				

	accord priority to the matter. The Joint Secretary, MoE, Government of India, advised that the matter may also be referred to the MoE.

	The BoG took note of the same.

Nominee) in the Building & Works Committee of IIIT Lucknow in terms of Section 23 (1)(2) of the Statutes of IIIT Lucknow		
	The BoG took note of the same. It was conveyed by Joint Secretary, MoE, Government of India, that currently, Sh. Priyank Chaturvedi is working as Deputy Secretary (IIITs). Hence, his name may be placed as Member (Central Govt. Nominee) in the Building and Works Committee of IIIT Lucknow now.		
Item No. 4.2	To apprise the BoG of the construction progress report submitted by UPRNN		
	The construction report submitted by Project monitoring Agency i.e. M/s UPRNN was placed before the BoG. It was apprised that 100% of the First Phase of work has been communicated by PMA as completed. However, the work pertaining to Rain Water Harvesting is not yet started. Further, the construction of boys hostel and other construction works viz. Director, Faculty & Staff Residence were also discussed. It was also apprised to the members that a preliminary estimate of Rs.4006.40 lakh for 474 bedded hostel has been received from UPRNN (PMC for First Phase) and also informed that the proposed boys hostel was not a part of the First Phase of construction (approved cost of Rs.128 Cr.). Further, the members were apprised that in the 2 nd meeting of the Finance Committee dated 16.05.2023, the FC recommends the allocation of IRG (Internal Resource generated) of the Institute fund for the construction of 474 bedded boys hostel within the estimated budget of Rs. 4006.40 Lakh. The members of BoG advised to come up with the recommendation of the Building & Works Committee of the Institute in this regard.

	The BoG was apprised about the approval of four tier flexible Faculty structure circulated by MoE vide letter No. F.No. 27-11/2011-Ts.I dt. 23.04.2014 in the 9th meeting of Governing Body held on 13.09.2019 as Faculty Recruitment Rules of the Institute. The Ministry of Education has requested the Educational Institutes to obtain the clarifications/interpretations, approved by their respective boards, if required. It was apprised that the policy document stipulates the CPDA Norms admissibility for the regular faculty and because of this, the facility could not be made available to the faculty members appointed in Pay Level 10/11. It was apprised to the members that the entry level grade in IIITs are Level 10/11 which as per Recruitment Rules are contractual. Further, as per Offer Letters provided to the faculty members, facilities as admissible to Regular Faculty Members are also extended to the faculty members appointed in Academic Pay Level 10/11. JS, MOE suggested that to provide more clarity, it may be written as:- "CPDA is extended to faculty in Pay Level 10/11 appointed as per Recruitment Rules of the Institute".
